PROPERTIES & USES:

- 1. AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040 is a macro-emulsion which is covering the fibre's surface and imparts very soft drappable and elastic hand feel to woven and knitted fabrics
- 2. AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040 improves the wash and wear properties and the crease recovery angle, sewability, tear strength and reduces abrasion.
- 3. The effect resist washing and dry cleaning
- 4. AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040 has very little effect on the degree of whiteness.
- 5. AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040 does not adversely affect the shade or color fastness of colored articles.
- 6. Can be used as is or in combination with other finishes such as nonionic and cationic softeners and resins.

APPLICATION:

- 1. Before adding to finishing bath check compatibility of product with all other ingredients of the bath.
- 2. If needed, predilute the product with cold water (1:1) before adding to finishing bath.
- 3. For application by padding use the following procedure:
 - a. Add water
 - b. Adjust pH to 5-6 with acetic acid.
 - c. Add AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040
 - d. Add other finishing ingredients
 - e. Pad and dry.

Dosing recommendation:

Apply 10 - 30 gr/l in the finishing bath according to the desired finishing effect.

Storage stability

AVCO-ELASTOGUM 3040 has a shelf life of at least 6 months if stored in originally sealed containers at 35°C and protected against direct sun. Expired date is after 6 months from the manufacturing date is shown on the product label

If stored open, in partially empty containers or exposed to direct sunlight (with water condensation on the container surface), an elevated concentration may occur at the surface, with the formation of a viscous milky-to transparent creamy gel.

Such creaming is not a sign of emulsion instability, but its high viscosity may cause problems during operation. Therefore, emulsions showing signs of creaming should be agitated before use to assure uniform consistency.

If necessary extremely viscous, poorly dispersed gel particles are removed by filtering before using.

Storage beyond the expired date does not necessarily mean that the product is no longer usable. In this case however, the product should be thoroughly agitated and the properties required for the intended use must be checked for quality assurance reasons.
